


LACERTA AND VISCOTEC: A VALUABLE RECYCLING PARTNERSHIP

of viscotec and Lacerta started in 2016 with the installation of a visco-SHEET extrusion line and other technology that makes Lacerta products FDA approved for food contact. The relationship between the two companies has developed into a trustworthy, material to make it FDA approved for long-term partnership. According to Mory Lotfi, Principal at Lacerta Group, forming lines are then used to convert "Continuous investment in machinery and technology is necessary to offer innovative solutions in the short and long term. For this purpose, Lacerta has relied on viscotec technology for many years. The company current-

ly runs four viscoSHEET extrusion lines for the in-house production of rPET sheet, and three deCON units. The deCON technology processes post-consumer and post-industrial food contact. State-of-the-art thermothe sheet into customized packaging solutions.

In January 2023, Lacerta acquired the production facility and other assets of Portage Plastics Corporation, packaging products manufacturer, growth story continues.



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Lacerta set themselves the goal to make 100% of their products include up to 100% of recycled, recyclable materials by 2025.
